

California Reds

Barbera \$2450

Produces a deep ruby-colored, full-bodied wine that is somewhat dry and tannic, ages well, softens with time.

Cabernet Sauvignon \$2450

Full-bodied with nice tannins, this jewel of California's crown produces a dry red wine with flavors typically described as black cherry and currant.

Merlot \$2450

A distinctively aromatic, spicy, medium-bodied red table wine with an abundance of fruit and a velvet-like quality that blends well with Cabernet Sauvignon.

Pinot Noir \$2400

Produces a wine that is clear, velvety, brilliant and medium to deep red in color with full flavors of cherries, plums, raspberries and strawberries.

Ruby Cabernet \$2450

This grape has a dry Cabernet-like aroma with good acidity and a fruity flavor.

Sangiovese \$2550

Produces a medium-bodied wine with spice, raspberry and cheery flavors. Blended with Cabernet, it produces a smoother wine with lighter tannins.

Shiraz \$2450

Makes a full-bodied, tannic wine that stands alone or blends well with any other grape.

Red Zinfandel \$2450

A dark-colored, medium, full-bodied, spicy wine with berry aromas that blends well.

Barolo \$2550

A blend of Nebbiolo, Barbera and Petite Shiraz grapes.

Brunello \$2550

A blend of Sangiovese, Barbera and Petite Shiraz grapes.

California Whites

Sauvignon Blanc \$2450

Possessing good fruit and citrus flavors, this grape is used to produce white table wines from sweet to dry.

Chardonnay \$2450

With flavors ranging from buttery to creamy to nutty to smoky, this grape yields a full-bodied wine.

Pinot Grigio \$2450

A classic Italian-style white wine with a nice color and a crisp fruity taste.

Riesling \$2450

This classic German grape variety is light in body, low in alcohol yet intensely flavored with a zesty bouquet.

Italian Whites

Trebbiano \$2450

A fresh and fruity grape that probably makes more white wine in the world than any other.

Lambrusco \$2450

Produces a dry wine with strawberry notes and a slight bitter finish.

Italian Reds

Merlot \$2700

A distinctively aromatic, spicy, medium-bodied red table wine with an abundance of fruit and a velvet-like quality that blends well with Cabernet Sauvignon.

Cabernet Sauvignon \$2700

Full-bodied with nice tannins, this jewel of California's crown produces a dry red wine with flavors typically described as black cherry and currant.

Shiraz \$2700

Makes a full-bodied, tannic wine that stands alone or blends well with any other grape.

Sangiovese \$2700

Fresh fruity flavors of strawberry and a little spiciness, but it readily takes on oaky, even tarry, flavors when aged in barrels.

Montepulciano \$2700

Typically produces a fruity, dry wine with soft tannins.
